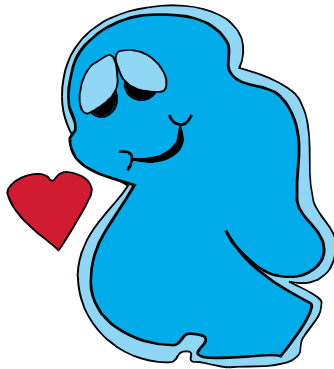
Need your love to be complete
